TRAGIC DEATH OF YOUNG CROAT WHO CAME TO CANADA IN SEARCH FOR A BETTER LIFE – WE ARE SEEKING YOUR HELP!

Branimir Poljak† (29) tragically died as a result of injuries sustained in a recent car accident near Dauphin (Manitoba). Last year in May, Branimir left his homeland of Croatia, including his mother and sister, extended family and friends, to come to Canada to work on a farm in Manitoba – in search of a better life and with the hope of being able to financially help his family back home. He had big aspirations, however, they unfortunately came to an abrupt end on November 14, 2015.

With no family in Canada, his mother and sister, who live modestly in his hometown of Koprivnica, are left in a very difficult position: the challenge of arranging, and the inability to pay, to have his body brought home for a proper burial. It will cost approximately \$15,000 to transfer his body home to his family.

While we did not know Branimir (nor do we know his family), as a community, we relate to his aspirations and sympathize with the pain and agony that his family is experiencing, and wish to ensure that he is properly laid to rest in his Homeland and that his mother has an opportunity to say goodbye to her son.
